

Supporting providers to understand the implications of 30 hours and other support to reduce the cost of childcare when business planning

If a parent is currently accessing a full time place for 51 weeks a year and is paying £4.50 per hour for their childcare they will currently have a bill of: **£11,475**

If they are currently accessing the universal entitlement they will already be making a saving of: **£2,565**

Current bill after free entitlement: £8,910

From September 2017, if the family are eligible they will make an additional saving of: **£2,565**

Which will reduce their childcare bill to: £6,345

If the family use Tax Free childcare they will be able to make a further saving of 20%: **£1,269**

New bill from September 2017: £5,076

If a family do not access Tax Free Childcare they can also make savings from Childcare Element of WTC, Universal Credit, Employer Vouchers and other subsidy schemes
