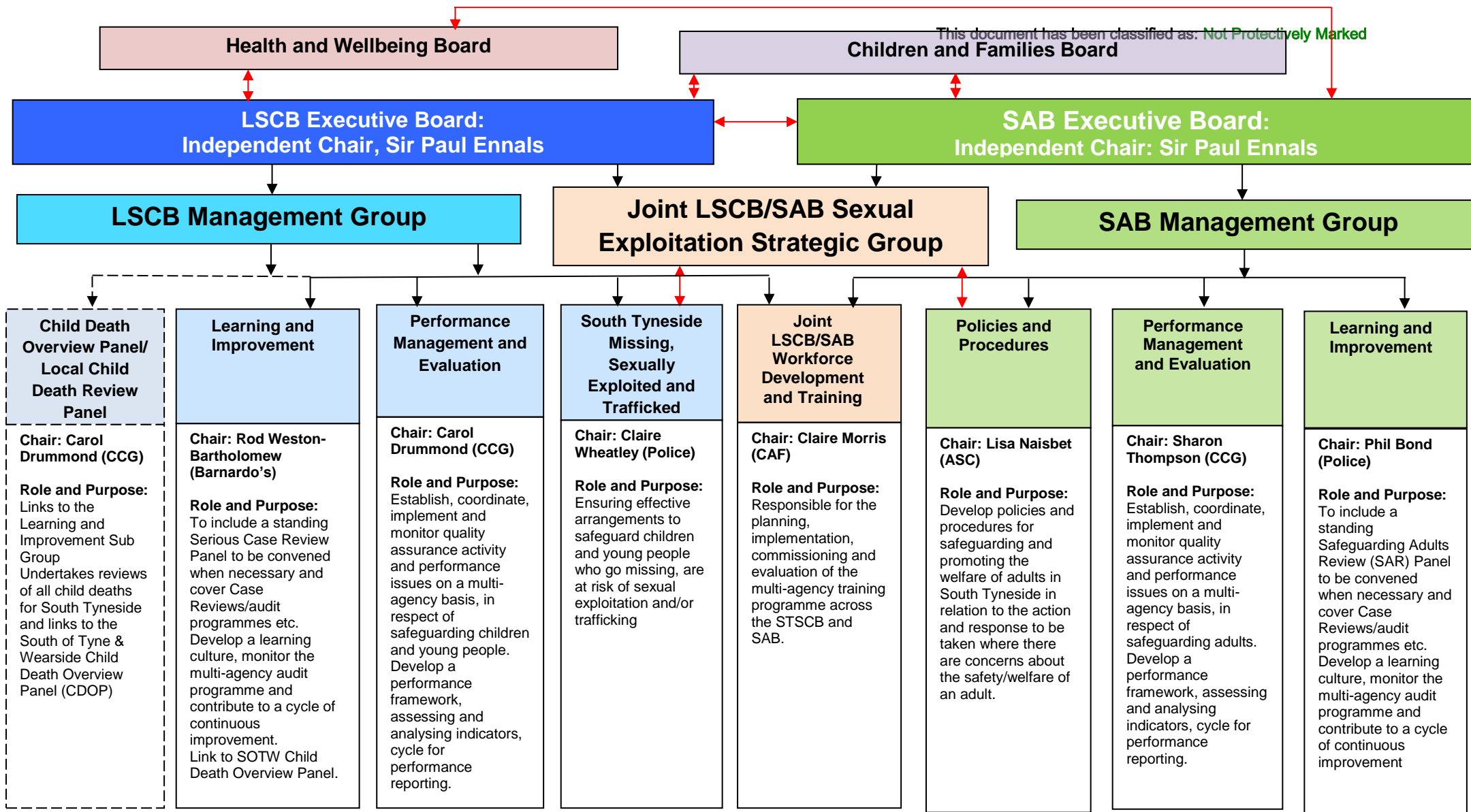

Child Death Overview Panel/ Local Child Death Review Panel
 Chair: Carol Drummond (CCG)
Role and Purpose: Links to the Learning and Improvement Sub Group Undertakes reviews of all child deaths for South Tyneside and links to the South of Tyne & Wearside Child Death Overview Panel (CDOP)

Learning and Improvement
 Chair: Rod Weston-Bartholomew (Barnardo's)
Role and Purpose: To include a standing Serious Case Review Panel to be convened when necessary and cover Case Reviews/audit programmes etc. Develop a learning culture, monitor the multi-agency audit programme and contribute to a cycle of continuous improvement. Link to SOTW Child Death Overview Panel.

Performance Management and Evaluation
 Chair: Carol Drummond (CCG)
Role and Purpose: Establish, coordinate, implement and monitor quality assurance activity and performance issues on a multi-agency basis, in respect of safeguarding children and young people. Develop a performance framework, assessing and analysing indicators, cycle for performance reporting.

South Tyneside Missing, Sexually Exploited and Trafficked
 Chair: Claire Wheatley (Police)
Role and Purpose: Ensuring effective arrangements to safeguard children and young people who go missing, are at risk of sexual exploitation and/or trafficking

Joint LSCB/SAB Workforce Development and Training
 Chair: Claire Morris (CAF)
Role and Purpose: Responsible for the planning, implementation, commissioning and evaluation of the multi-agency training programme across the STSCB and SAB.

Policies and Procedures
 Chair: Lisa Naisbet (ASC)
Role and Purpose: Develop policies and procedures for safeguarding and promoting the welfare of adults in South Tyneside in relation to the action and response to be taken where there are concerns about the safety/welfare of an adult.

Performance Management and Evaluation
 Chair: Sharon Thompson (CCG)
Role and Purpose: Establish, coordinate, implement and monitor quality assurance activity and performance issues on a multi-agency basis, in respect of safeguarding adults. Develop a performance framework, assessing and analysing indicators, cycle for performance reporting.

Learning and Improvement
 Chair: Phil Bond (Police)
Role and Purpose: To include a standing Safeguarding Adults Review (SAR) Panel to be convened when necessary and cover Case Reviews/audit programmes etc. Develop a learning culture, monitor the multi-agency audit programme and contribute to a cycle of continuous improvement
