DECISION BY SOUTH TYNESIDE COUNCIL TO PROCEED WITH DEVELOPMENT OF A SINGLE PERMIT SCHEME IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PERMIT SCHEME (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2007 AND THE DEREGULATION ACT 2015.

In accordance with regulation 3 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007, SOUTH TYNESIDE COUNCIL is proceeding with the development of a single Permit Scheme.

The council will be developing the Cost Benefit Analysis and scheme which will be submitted for consultation in accordance with the DfT advice note "For local authorities developing or varying permit schemes, June 2016" in due course. Scheme development work is underway and we are now encouraging early engagement with all stakeholders as to the design and operation of the permit scheme.

We are particularly interested in ideas for how the scheme could encourage environmentally friendly working practices, joined up working and other positive working arrangements.
