South Tyneside Council Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities Order 2019

Made - 16 January 2020

Coming into Force - 2nd March 2020

South Tyneside Council in exercise of its powers conferred by section 33A (2) of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order -

1. This Order may be cited as the 'South Tyneside Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities Order 2019' and shall come into force on 02/03/2020.
2. South Tyneside Council acting as the Local Highway Authority for all streets under its control within the whole area encompassed by the authority's boundary approves the South Tyneside Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities which is set out in the Schedule to this Order.
3. The South Tyneside Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities set out in the Schedule to this Order complies with all aspects of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 as amended by the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2015, with all other primary and secondary legislation in relation to Traffic Management Permit Schemes, and does not exceed the powers provided under such legislation.
4. The South Tyneside Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities set out in the Schedule to this Order comes into effect on 02/03/2020.
5. Part 8 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 shall apply to the specified streets within the South Tyneside Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities.
