

To whom it may concern

My wife and I have lived in Market Dock since our house was built 20 years ago. Feb 1999
We used to enjoy walking along the walkway from the Ferry Gangway to Wapping Street and on to the sea front promenade, as did many other people from the Market Dock Estate, other residents of South Shields and visitors to the town.

This was always a walkway along Long Row number 4 dock around the smaller number 3 dock then in front of Garlands Call Centre where seating was available, so people could rest and enjoy the river view,

For some reason a barrier was erected with a notice to say "No access, Unsafe structure." This was a truly false statement. Later the barrier was replaced by gates with a sign "South Quays Marina" even if the actual area is in Market Dock.

We personally object to it being closed and would like to see it reopened.
